CORVALLIS MIDDL SCHOOL PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

It is the belief of the administration and staff that participation in extracurricular programs is a privilege extended to you by your school.. You will be representing your school and the community. We expect you to have pride in yourself, your activity, and Corvallis Middle School. You will strive to be a good citizen at all times. These rules will cover the period from the first day of fall practice through/including the last day of school.

RULES

1. Maintain a 2.0 GPA (70%). This GPA is calculated on all classes taken.
 - a) A student who does not have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 (70%) calculated on all classes will be placed on probation for seven (7) days.
 - b) A student who continues to have a cumulative GPA of less then 2.0 after the probationary period will be ineligible to participate until the GPA standard is met.
 - c) A student who receives a failing grade (below 60%) in the core areas of Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies, Reading, or Computers will be assigned a lunchtime study period that week (on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday) until the next eligibility check is made. If another failing grade is made in a core area, the study period will continue the next week. Students must attend each assigned study period and work productively to remain eligible for the week.
 - d) Eligibility slips need to be signed by a parent and returned to the learning lab no later than the Wednesday of the week that study hall has been assigned. If slips are not returned by Wednesday, the student is ineligible to participate in the next game or activity.
 - e) Any suspensions received during the week will result in ineligibility. (When an athlete is ineligiblehe/she may practice, but not play).
2. No use of , association with or possession of alcohol, tobacco products or other non-prescription illegal drugs.
 - a) 1st offense—The student will be suspended from all extracurricular activities for a period of 2 months from date of return to school.
 - b) 2nd offense—The student will be suspended from all extracurricular activities for a period of 6 months from date of return to school.
3. Attend school
 - a) You are required to be in school at least half a day in order to practice or participate in an event. This includes attendance after a morning practice session. You must be in school the half of the day closest to the practice or competition.
 - b) Should practice or competition fall on a holiday or weekend, you must be in attendance the last day of school prior to the activity.
4. Follow all school-related policies as stated in the student handbook
5. Each coach may have additional guidelines for his/her participants to follow during the season.
